REGISTERING TO VOTE?

3 CHOICES for College-University Students

PA law allows eligible students living away from home to choose either their home address or their new address when registering to vote.

- 1. I want to go home to vote at my HOME polling place.
 - This is easy—just make sure you use your HOME ADDRESS when you register to vote and that you are home to vote on Election Day.
- 2. Not going home, but I want to vote for candidates from my HOME DISTRICT (especially important for Municipal Elections):
 - Use your HOME ADDRESS when you register to vote.
 - Apply for a Mail-in Ballot online at vote.pa.gov or at your state's voter registration portal.
 - When you receive your mail-in ballot, immediately follow the directions to complete and return it to the address provided.

- 3. Vote where I CURRENTLY receive my mail in PA.
- SCAN above or go to vote.pa.gov:
 - Register to vote before the deadline OR
 - If already registered, update your voter registration with your <u>CURRENT ADDRESS</u> at least 15 days before the election.
