IMPORTANT: You MAY NOT REGISTER or VOTE While Incarcerated for a Felony:



- 1) IF you are currently incarcerated for a felony and will still be incarcerated on Election Day.
- 2) IF you are in a halfway house* or alternative correctional facility on pre-release status for conviction of a felony and will still be confined on Election Day.

Note: Voting is not allowed for four years after conviction of a felony violation of any provision of the PA Election Code.

If any of the above apply to you, you MAY NOT register to vote or vote. But remember the rule, "When your feet hit the street" you can register and vote.
