2 Ways You Can VOTE EARLY



OR



Vote Early with a Mail-in Ballot: Apply for an Online or Printed Application at Vote.PA.gov/MailBallot

- Complete the ballot correctly, when you receive it. Follow the step-by-step directions for the ballot and the envelope, so that your vote is counted!
- Return the pre-addressed envelope in the mail to the Election office well before the deadline.
- Postmarks do not count and you will need a stamp.

Vote Early at Your Elections Office with a Mail-in Ballot--*check office hours*

- Go to the **County Elections office** to apply for, complete, and then submit your mail-in ballot ***all in one visit***.
- Bring your **Driver's License**, **PennDOT ID** or the last four 4 digits of your **Social Security Number**.
- You can vote early when the Mail-in Application process opens—about 30 days before Election Day.
