2 Ways You Can VOTE EARLY



Vote Early with a Mail-in Ballot: <u>Apply</u> for an Online or Printed Application at <u>Vote.PA.gov/MailBallot</u>

- •Complete the ballot correctly, when you receive it. Follow the step-by-step directions for the ballot and the envelope, so that your vote is counted!
- Return the pre-addressed envelope in the mail to the Election office well before the deadline.
- Postmarks do not count and you will need a stamp.

OR



Vote Early at <u>Your Elections Office</u> with a Mail-in Ballot--check office hours

- Go to the **County Elections office** to apply for, complete, and then submit your mail-in ballot *all in one visit*.
- •Bring your **Driver's License**, **PennDOT ID** or the last four 4 digits of your **Social Security Number**.
- •You can vote early when the Mail-in Application process opens—about 30 days before Election Day.
