

## **INSTRUCTIONS for: a VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATION**

**CHOICE #1—Complete the ONLINE** <u>Voter Registration Application</u> if you have a PA Driver's License, OR PennDOT ID, OR the last four digits of your Social Security #, with an uploaded signature.

## Follow the ONLINE Instructions (selected entries are highlighted below)

- -#1 Legal name
- -#2 "Eligibility"; #3 "Reason" "New Registration". Complete all checked boxes.
- -#4 BIRTH DATE is required (18 years old on or by next election day)- mm/dd/YYYY.
- -#4 Phone number and email are not required but are recommended so the County Election Office can contact you.
- -#5 Address; County is required; Municipality is not required.
- -#7 Identification; Only ONE form of ID is required--Driver's License OR PennDot ID OR last 4 digits SS# w/signature.
- -#8 Political Party— can only vote in Primary Election if choose Democratic or Republican.
- **-#9- Voting Assistance** Skip unless you need *physical assistance to vote.*
- -#10 Changing voter registration information—can do anytime at vote.pa.gov.
- -#11 Declaration- must check.
- -#13 Poll Workers are needed!
- -#15 <u>Annual Mail Ballot Request</u>—You may choose to receive "Annual" Mail-in Ballots" by clicking on that option. If you are an "Annual" Mail-in (or Absentee) voter, your County Election Office will send you a renewal application every year in February and you will be on their "permanent voter list". If your application for the Annual Mail-in/Absentee Ballot is approved, you will receive a Mail-in or Absentee ballot for every election in that calendar year—primary, general, and special elections. You may check your status <a href="here">here</a>—the question, "Are you a permanent voter", will be checked "yes" or "no". If you move, you must update your voter registration address at <a href="here">vote.pa.gov</a>. To cancel this option, click <a href="here">here</a>.

## CHOICE #2—Complete the Voter Registration PRINTED Application

Print the Blank Form: Follow the PRINTED form Instructions (selected entries are highlighted below.) Use black ink. -#1 Legal name

- #2 "Eligibility" and #3 "Reason"-"New Registration". Complete all checked boxes.
- -#4 BIRTH DATE is required (18 years old on or by next election day)- mm/dd/YYYY
- -#4 Phone number and email are not required but are helpful if the County Election Office needs to contact you.
- -#5 Address; County is required; Municipality is not required.
- -#7 Identification: Only ONE form of ID is required-- Driver's License OR PennDot ID OR Last 4 digits of your SS#.
- -#8 Political Party-- can only vote in Primary Election if choose Democratic or Republican party.
- -#9 Voting assistance- Skip unless you need physical assistance to vote.
- -#10 Changing voter registration information—can do anytime at vote.pa.gov.
- -#11 Declaration: In the BOX, write your SIGNATURE, PRINT YOUR NAME below and TODAY'S DATE below that.

Once you have completed the Voter Registration Printed Application, MAIL your application to:

## **Voter Registration Card**

- An official looking ENVELOPE that you will receive in the mail will hold your Voter Registration ID Card.
- After you send in your Voter Registration Application, (and after you turn 18-years old) it may take **3 weeks** before you receive this envelope in the mail with your Voter Registration ID Card inside. **Don't lose it!**
- If you don't receive your ID card after that time, contact your <u>county election office</u>. (Allegheny County Elections Division can be reached at 412-350-4500.)
- Be aware of deadlines for voter registration applications and mail-in ballot applications.

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
