Deadlines, But Do NOW

If mailing, do at least 2 weeks before:

May 3: Last day to register to vote.

May 11: Last day to apply for mail-in or absentee ballot.

May 18: Election Day and the last day for mail-in or absentee ballots to be received by 8pm.

Who...is eligible to vote?

- All US citizens age 18 or older as of May 18, 2021

 PA residents for 30 days prior to May 18, 2021

Where...can I get a voter registration form, mail-in or absentee ballot application?

- **VotesPA.com:** Complete and submit your registration form or mailin/absentee ballot application online OR download, print, and mail forms to your county elections office. If completing online, you must have a PA driver's license or PennDOT ID.
- Allegheny County Elections Division: Call, visit, or mail request for registration form and mail-in/absentee ballot application to: Allegheny County Elections Division, 542 Forbes Ave., Suite 609, Pittsburgh, PA 15219. Phone: 412-350-4500.

What...ways can I vote?

- By Mail: All registered voters are eligible to apply for a mail-in or absentee ballot. Instructions on how to apply for and submit your mail-in or absentee ballot are available at VotesPA.com or by calling your elections office or League of Women Voters. After application approval and printing of ballots, a ballot will be mailed to you.
- In-Person: At your polling place on Election Day--May 18, 2021 between 7am - 8pm.

How...do I complete my mail-in/absentee ballot?

- 1. Mark your ballot, following the instructions.
- 2. Place your ballot in the secrecy envelope and seal it. Put the secrecy envelope into the official envelope. Complete all information on the back of the official envelope and sign the declaration.
- 3. Return your ballot to arrive at the County Election Office no later than 8pm May 18, 2021. Postmarks do not count.

What...do I need to vote in-person on Election Day?

Bring your voter registration card or another valid ID. If poll workers say you are not on the voter's list, DON'T LEAVE WITHOUT VOTING! Request and complete a Provisional Ballot. Save your receipt.
